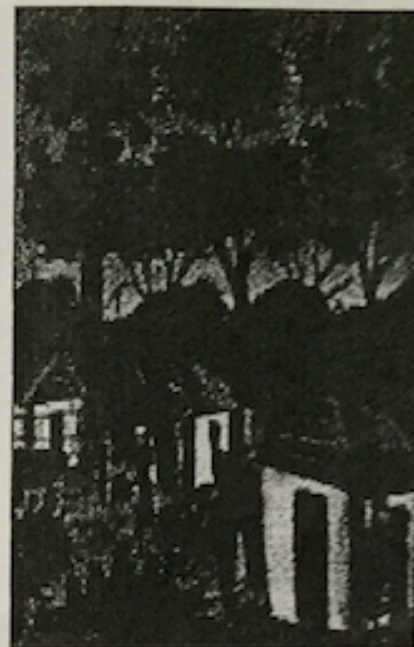


# Creole Phrases...
